ORDER

On June 4, 2019, Thomas and Phoebe DeVaughn filed a formal complaint against Charter Communications, Inc., alleging difficulties with video service. Pursuant to MCL 484.3310(5), a mediation recommendation was issued to the parties on July 1, 2019, by Administrative Law Judge Kandra K. Robbins. The Uniform Video Services Local Franchise Act, MCL 484.3310(5)(b)(i), provides, in pertinent part: "The complaint shall be resolved by 1 of the following: (i) . . . The mediator shall make recommendations for resolution within 30 days from the date of appointment. Within 10 days of the date of the mediator's recommendations, any named party in the complaint may request a contested case as provided under subparagraph (ii)." Neither party requested a contested case within 10 days of the issuance of the mediation recommendation. Accordingly, the complaint is considered to be settled and the Commission finds that the complaint should be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the formal complaint filed by Thomas and Phoebe DeVaughn against Charter Communications, Inc. is dismissed.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, pursuant to MCL 484.3314(4) and MCL 484.2203(12). To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel.
