ORDER

On April 5, 2019, the Cypress Creek QFs [qualifying facilities]¹ filed a joint complaint against Consumers Energy Company (Consumers) for violations of the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978, Pub L No 95-617, 92 Stat 3117, 16 USC § 2601 *et seq.* (PURPA), implementing regulations promulgated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, the Commission's orders in Case No. U-18090, and Consumers' tariff.

On August 8, 2019, Consumers filed an application in Case No. U-20615 for approval of a settlement agreement that broadly resolves the rights and obligations under PURPA between Consumers and QFs who are signatories to that agreement. Cypress Creek Renewables, LLC,

signed the settlement agreement on behalf of itself and its wholly owned subsidiaries, the Cypress Creek QFs. On September 11, 2019, the Commission issued an order approving the settlement agreement. The order was docketed in Case No. U-20615 and in this complaint proceeding, Case No. U-20516. On September 20, 2019, the parties filed in this case a joint stipulation for voluntary withdrawal of the complaint and request for order dismissing the complaint with prejudice.

The Commission has reviewed the joint stipulation for voluntary withdrawal of the complaint and request for dismissal of the complaint with prejudice and finds that the request to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is reasonable and consistent with the settlement agreement approved on September 11, 2019, in Case No. U-20615.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint of the Cypress Creek QFs against Consumers Energy Company is dismissed with prejudice in accordance with the joint stipulation.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26. To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel.
