ORDER

On December 3, 2010, Voxbeam Telecommunications Inc.(Voxbeam) filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service throughout the state of Michigan in the zone and exchange areas in which Frontier North Inc., f/k/a Verizon North Inc., and Frontier Midstates Inc., f/k/a Contel of the South, Inc., d/b/a Verizon North Systems, and AT&T Michigan are the incumbent local exchange carriers. On May 26, 2011, Voxbeam was granted a permanent license.

On August 12, 2020, Voxbeam informed the Commission of its intent to voluntarily surrender the license. Voxbeam states that the company has had a change in its business strategy and no longer seeks to provide local and exchange access services. Voxbeam reports that it does not have any customers or outstanding obligations such as deposits, prepayments, or advance payments.

Based on the information that Voxbeam provided, the Commission finds that the request to voluntarily surrender its license should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The license of Voxbeam Telecommunications Inc. to provide basic local exchange service is voluntarily surrendered.

B. Voxbeam Telecommunications Inc. shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12). To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 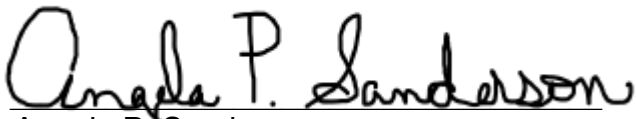
