**ORDER**

On October 13, 2020, Bloomingdale Telephone Company, Inc. (Bloomingdale) filed a complaint against AT&T Corp. (AT&T). On October 26, 2020, Bloomingdale filed an erratum to one of its proposed exhibits. On November 2, 2020, AT&T filed its answer and affirmative defenses to the complaint.

On December 11, 2020, Bloomingdale filed a notice of settlement and proof of service. On January 11, 2021, Bloomingdale filed a stipulation for voluntary dismissal with prejudice (stipulation) that was signed by both parties and indicated the terms of the settlement were confidential. On January 12, 2021, Administrative Law Judge Sharon L. Feldman transmitted the matter to the Commission for its consideration.

The Commission has reviewed the stipulation and finds that the matter should be dismissed with prejudice. Accordingly, the complaint filed by Bloomingdale against AT&T is dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the complaint filed by Bloomingdale Telephone Company, Inc., on October 13, 2020, against AT&T Corp. is dismissed with prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must file a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of this order, pursuant to MCL 484.2203(12). To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 
