ORDER

On May 8, 2001, RACC Enterprises, LLC (RACC) filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101 *et seq.*, for a license to provide basic local exchange service in all exchanges currently served by Ameritech Michigan; Verizon North Inc.; Contel of the South, Inc., d/b/a Verizon North Systems; CenturyTel of Michigan, Inc.; CenturyTel of Northern Michigan, Inc.; CenturyTel Midwest, Inc.; and CenturyTel of the Upper Peninsula, Inc. On August 16, 2001, RACC was granted a permanent license.

On October 6, 2022, RACC filed a letter requesting to voluntarily surrender its license to provide basic local exchange service (October 6 letter). The October 6 letter explains that RACC terminated its operations on October 1, 2020, for basic local exchange service throughout the state

of Michigan. All customers have been transferred to other providers, and RACC no longer has any customers.

The Commission finds that RACC's request to voluntarily surrender its license to provide basic local exchange service should be granted because the company is no longer providing any competitive local exchange carrier regulated service in Michigan and has no customers. Accordingly, RACC's request is approved.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. The license of RACC Enterprises, LLC, to provide basic local exchange service is voluntarily surrendered.

B. RACC Enterprises, LLC, shall surrender to the North American Numbering Plan Administrator any numbers that have been assigned to it for the purpose of providing basic local exchange service in Michigan under the license.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so by the filing of a claim of appeal in the Michigan Court of Appeals within 30 days of the issuance of this order, under MCL 484.2203(12). To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 
