**ORDER**

The following parties have filed joint applications for approval of interconnection agreements  
or amendments to an interconnection agreement:

Case No. U-17119	AT&T Michigan and TelNet Worldwide, Inc. Application filed July 6, 2023, for approval of an eleventh amendment to the interconnection agreement (modifies certain provisions related to operations support systems and/or data connection security requirements).
Case No. U-17140	Brightspeed of Michigan, Inc., f/k/a CenturyTel of Michigan, Inc.; Brightspeed of Central Michigan, Inc., f/k/a CenturyTel Midwest-Michigan, Inc.; Brightspeed of Northern Michigan, Inc., f/k/a CenturyTel of Northern Michigan, Inc.; and Brightspeed of Upper Michigan, Inc., f/k/a/ CenturyTel of Upper Michigan, Inc. and Charter Fiberlink – Michigan, LLC Application filed July 6, 2023, and amended application filed July 10, 2023, for approval of a second amendment to the traffic exchange agreement (adds terms and conditions for operations support systems, billing support systems, local number portability, wholesale services, and escalation procedures and expires October 3, 2024).

47 USC 252(e)(2) and (3) provides in part:

- (2) The State commission may only reject
  - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) of this section if it finds that--
    - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or
    - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity; . . .
- (3) Notwithstanding paragraph (2), but subject to section 253 of this title, nothing in this section shall prohibit a State commission from establishing or enforcing other requirements of State law in its review of an agreement, including requiring compliance with intrastate telecommunications service quality standards or requirements.

After reviewing the applications, the Commission finds that they should be approved. The Commission finds that the agreements and amendments are consistent with federal and state law and are in the public interest. Under 47 USC 252(i) and MCL 484.2359(2), the services provided under the agreements shall be made available to other telecommunications carriers upon the same terms and conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- A. The interconnection agreements and amendments listed above are approved.
- B. Approval of the interconnection agreements and amendments does not alter the duty of the parties to comply with relevant federal and state law and past and future Commission orders and rules.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party aggrieved by this order may file an action in the appropriate federal District Court under 47 USC 252(e)(6). To comply with the requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel. 
