**ERRATA**

On January 23, 2025, the Commission issued an order in this proceeding. On page 2 of the order, the following sentence appears:

TNG currently provides electricity to about 100,000 customers in in Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Ohio, New Hampshire, Maryland, Illinois, New Jersey, Rhode Island, New York, Delaware, Texas,<sup>2</sup> and Washington, D.C.

The sentence is corrected to read:

Think Energy, LLC (Think Energy), TNG’s affiliate, currently serves approximately 100,000 electricity customers in Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Ohio, New Hampshire, Maryland, Illinois, New Jersey, Rhode Island, New York, Delaware, Texas,<sup>2</sup> and Washington, D.C. TNG does not currently hold any natural gas or electric licenses in other states.

On page 2 of the order, the following footnote appears:

<sup>2</sup> TNG is not a licensed retail electric provider (REP) in Texas. TNG is a subsidiary of Energywell Retail Holdings, LLC, which is also the parent company of Think Energy, LLC (Think Energy). Think Energy is a licensed REP in Texas. As an affiliate of Think Energy, TNG provides back-office services (such as billing, customer care, complaint handling, etc.) through a contractual relationship with Think Energy for Texas-based customers, which is why these customers are included in this residential customer equivalent count.

The footnote is corrected to read:

<sup>2</sup> Think Energy is not a licensed retail electric provider (REP) in Texas. Think+ Network is a registered broker in Texas and acquired these customers on behalf of a licensed REP in Texas. An affiliate of Think Energy, through a contractual

relationship with that REP, provides back-office services (such as billing, customer care, complaint handling, etc.) for that REP's customers, which is why they are included in this residential customer equivalent count.

On page 3 of the order, the following sentences appear:

The Staff's review of TNG's application also included a review of formal complaints or investigations, energy related penalties and fines, and any energy violations of law and business ethics in the other 12 states and Washington, D.C. where TNG holds a license to supply natural gas. Currently, there are no open lawsuits or formal complaints.

The sentences are corrected to read:

The Staff's review of TNG's application also included a review of formal complaints or investigations, energy related penalties and fines, and any energy violations of law and business ethics in any jurisdiction where TNG holds a license to supply natural gas. As TNG does not currently hold any licenses to supply natural gas, there are no open lawsuits or formal complaints.


