**ORDER**

On February 27, 2024, Governor Gretchen Whitmer signed into law Public Act 235 of 2023 (Act 235), which amended Public Act 295 of 2008 (Act 295), as amended by Public Act 342 of 2016. Section 22 of Act 295, as amended, MCL 460.1022, requires electric providers to submit an annual renewable energy plan (REP) that demonstrates how the electric provider will meet the renewable portfolio standards (RPS) set forth in Section 28 of Act 295, as amended. The RPS enacted by Act 235 requires electric providers to achieve a renewable energy credit (REC) portfolio of 15% through 2029, 50% from 2030 through 2034, and 60% in 2035, and each year thereafter. For member-regulated cooperatives, municipally owned utilities, and alternative electric suppliers (AESs), the Commission is required to provide an opportunity for public

comment on the electric provider's amended REP. On February 8, 2024, the Commission issued an order in Case No. U-21568 (February 8 order) directing member-regulated cooperatives, municipally owned utilities, and AESs to file their respective amended REPs no later than February 27, 2025. February 8 order, pp. 2, 4.

On February 14, 2025, Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC (Calpine Energy) filed a petition<sup>1</sup> in Case No. U-16650 requesting an extension of the REC portfolio deadline pursuant to Section 32 of Act 235, MCL 460.1032. Calpine recites the statutory standard for granting an extension under Section 32 and explains that it has satisfied the good cause criteria required by the statute by making reasonable efforts to comply with Act 235. Calpine explains that it was unable to comply because of a lack of compliant product availability, long project development timelines, and the lack of clarity in the compliance requirements. Thus, following a recitation of the statutory requirements for an extension under Section 32, Calpine requests that the Commission grant its request for a two-year extension to file its amended REP. In explaining its new compliance plan, Calpine Energy states that it will continue to operate under its existing REP and will continue to engage with the market and work towards compliance with steps specified in its confidentially filed petition. Calpine Energy's petition, pp. 1-7.

On February 26, 2025, Direct Energy Business, LLC (Direct Energy) filed in Case No. U-16643 a petition (Direct Energy's petition)<sup>2</sup> for an extension of the REC portfolio deadline pursuant to Section 32 of Act 235, MCL 460.1032. In Direct Energy's petition, it explains that its parent company, NRG Energy, Inc., issued its last renewable energy request for offers on

September 10, 2024, but that the pricing of the responding offers would make compliance with the RPS requirements excessively costly and it would be outside of Direct Energy's ability to reduce such costs. Direct Energy contends that despite its good faith efforts to source commercial products to achieve RPS compliance under Act 235, it has been unable to do so in the applicable timeframe. Direct Energy recites the statutory authority for an extension under Section 32 of Act 235 and asserts that it has met the applicable criteria of good cause such that the Commission should grant its request for a two-year extension to comply with Act 235. In the meantime, Direct Energy states that, in accordance with Section 22(1), it will continue to operate under its existing REP. Direct Energy's petition, pp. 1-5.

Section 32 provides as follows:

(1) Upon petition by an electric provider, the commission may, upon a showing of good cause, grant an extension of a renewable energy credit portfolio deadline under section 28. Each extension shall not exceed 2 years. An extension of a deadline does not affect a subsequent deadline.

(2) In a petition under subsection (1), an electric provider must include a plan for resolving the barrier to compliance and must make a showing of good cause by demonstrating any of the following:

(a) Despite all commercially reasonable efforts by the electric provider to comply with the deadline, compliance is not practically feasible for reasons that may include, but are not limited to, zoning, siting, permitting, supply chains, transmission interconnection, labor shortages, delays in project deliverability from developers, or unanticipated load growth. Issuing a request for proposals to purchase renewable energy and not receiving a commercially viable offer creates a rebuttable presumption that compliance with the deadline is not practically feasible.

(b) Compliance would be excessively costly to customers despite commercially reasonable efforts by the electric provider to contain costs.

(c) Compliance would result in a deficiency in meeting resource adequacy requirements in the electric provider's service territory.

(d) Compliance would result in a local grid reliability issue.

(3) Upon granting an additional extension for a particular renewable energy credit portfolio deadline beyond the first 2 extensions, the commission shall notify the speaker of the house, the majority leader of the senate, and the chairpersons of the committees of the legislature having jurisdiction over energy issues that it has granted an additional extension to the electric provider and the reasons for the extension.

MCL 460.1032.

The Commission has reviewed the respective petitions for extensions of the REC portfolio deadline filed by Calpine Energy and Direct Energy and finds that more information is needed to evaluate the current state of the market and the reasonableness of the respective companies' efforts to comply. The Commission notes that the petitions to extend the REC portfolio deadline were filed in February of this year and acknowledges the challenges faced by both Calpine Energy and Direct Energy as the market continues to develop. At the same time, the Commission finds that there is merit in refreshing the companies' efforts to procure sufficient resources to comply with Act 235, particularly given that there may have been material changes in the availability of suitable resources since Calpine Energy and Direct Energy first initiated their compliance procurement activities, and that the recent federal tax changes may have had an impact on project availability and price.

As such, Calpine Energy and Direct Energy shall meet with the Commission Staff (Staff) not later than February 16, 2026, to discuss recent market developments, including any continuing challenges, areas of uncertainty around the Commission's directives and expectations, and any notable changes since the company's initial filings. At this meeting, Calpine Energy and Direct Energy shall detail the ways in which the companies are refreshing their RFPs and/or other procurement activities and describe their expected compliance pathways beyond this first two-year period. Following this meeting and not later than April 15, 2026, Calpine Energy and Direct Energy shall provide an opportunity for the Staff to review and audit the responses from additional

RFPs and/or other procurement activities to support the recommendations the Staff shall make to the Commission following the Staff's review. The Commission will then review the reasonableness of the each company's compliance efforts, including any extensions, at that time.

By February 27, 2025, all member-regulated cooperatives, municipally owned utilities, and AESs named in the above-captioned dockets, with the exception of the electric providers discussed above and in footnote 3 of this order,<sup>3</sup> had filed with the Commission their amended REPs pursuant to Section 22 of Act 235 or had previously filed notices that they were no longer serving customers in Michigan. The Commission provided an opportunity for public comment on each of the electric providers' respective amended REPs. The Staff reviewed each amended REP and determined that the amended REPs complied with Act 295, as amended. Thus, the Commission finds that all electric providers required to do so have filed timely amended REPs that are compliant with the RPS requirements of Act 295, as amended.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. All member-regulated cooperatives, municipally owned utilities, and alternative electric suppliers required to do so, with the exceptions described in this order, have filed timely renewable energy plans as required by Public Act 295 of 2008, as amended.

B. Member-regulated cooperatives, municipally owned utilities, and alternative electric suppliers serving retail customers may continue to voluntarily file annual reports regarding their actions to comply with Michigan's renewable energy standards in their renewable energy plan dockets by June 30 each year.

C. Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC, and Direct Energy Business, LLC, shall meet with the Commission Staff no later than February 16, 2026, to discuss pathways to compliance with Public Act 295 of 2008, as amended, as described in this order.

D. The petition for an extension of the renewable energy credit portfolio deadline pursuant to Section 32 of Public Act 235 of 2023, MCL 460.1032, filed by Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC, is deferred, at this time, to be considered subsequent to the company's meeting with the Commission Staff and the Commission Staff's review of the additional request for proposals or procurement activity documents described in this order.

E. The petition for an extension of the renewable energy credit portfolio deadline pursuant to Section 32 of Public Act 235 of 2023, MCL 460.1032, filed by Direct Energy Business, LLC, is deferred, at this time, to be considered subsequent to the company's meeting with the Commission Staff and the Commission Staff's review of the additional request for proposals or procurement activity documents described in this order.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, pursuant to MCL 462.26. To comply with the Michigan Rules of Court's requirement to notify the Commission of an appeal, appellants shall send required notices to both the Commission's Executive Secretary and to the Commission's Legal Counsel.


