SUPPLEMENT TO THE MICHIGAN PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION'S EX PARTE PRESENTATION PURSUANT TO THE COMMISSION'S REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Pursuant to the Commission's request of May 25, 2001, the Michigan Public Service Commission's ("MPSC") hereby provides this Supplement to the additional information clarifying its petition for additional delegated authority to implement number conservation measures that was filed on May 24, 2001. Specifically, the MPSC discusses whether the majority of wireline carriers in Michigan are LNP-capable. Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, an original and one copy of this letter are being filed with the Office of the Secretary.

Over 95% of the customers in Michigan are serviced by wireline carriers that are LNP capable. Specifically, the carriers are broken down as follows:

- Ameritech Michigan: has over 80% of total wireline customers in Michigan, and they are 100% LNP capable.
- Verizon (formerly GTE): has over 15% of customers in Michigan, and they are approximately 98% LNP capable.

• The MPSC would have to survey the carriers serving the remaining 5% of the Michigan customers to accurately assess their LNP capability, but it does not believe those carriers are LNP capable.
