PUBLIC COMMENT: Members of the public who wish to make comment may do so during the public comment portion of the meeting, subject to the following requirements. Comments should be limited to no longer than three (3) minutes; however, the Commission will manage the public comment process and may adjust or place further limits on how long a person may speak. Public comment must be directed to the commissioners and should not be used to engage with other participants or respond to their comments. The public comment period is an opportunity for commissioners to listen to comments and concerns. Public comments should be limited to one per person. The meeting may be recorded.
