On November 12, 2025, an Application for Approval of Renewable Energy Plan was filed with the Michigan Public Service Commission (Commission) to fully comply with Public Act 295 of 2008, as amended by Public Act 235 of 2023.

Bayfield Electric Cooperative, Inc. shall mail, by January 5, 2026, a copy of the enclosed Notice of Opportunity to Comment to all Michigan cities, incorporated villages, townships and counties in which Bayfield Electric Cooperative, Inc. serves customers.

Bayfield Electric Cooperative, Inc. shall fulfill its publication and service obligation by: 1) causing the enclosed Notice of Opportunity to Comment to be published in newspapers of general circulation within its Michigan areas of service by January 5, 2026, **or** 2) mailing a copy of the enclosed Notice of Opportunity to Comment to each of its Michigan customers individually through the United States mail by January 5, 2026, **or** 3) causing the enclosed Notice of Opportunity to Comment to be published in Country Lines by January 5, 2026. Bayfield Electric Cooperative, Inc. shall also provide prospective Michigan customers with information on its renewable energy plan in its marketing material. Proof of Service shall be filed with the Commission by February 5, 2026.

The notice must indicate that comments are due by 5:00 p.m. on February 5, 2026. The notice shall advise customers that comments received in this matter become public information, posted on the Commission's website, and subject to disclosure. Comments should not include information commenters wish to remain private.

Affidavits of publication shall be filed with the Commission by February 5, 2026.
